Phase 2 will consist of the sanitary flow for proposed Buildings 7-10 & 27-29 as well as approval for construction and operation of manhole S-168 & the immediate downstream sanitary sewer pipe.

WHEREAS, TNSA Consulting Engineer, Jeffrey Fedorchak of Remington & Vernick Engineers, has reviewed the provided projected flows; the facility will generate a total of 21,600 GPD of sanitary sewage with TWA Phase 2. The Neptune Sewage Authority (TNSA) has been requested to review the application and plans regarding the above referenced project.

The TNSA has received the following information for review:

- 1. One copy of the cover letter, prepared by Colliers Engineering & Design, dated November 7, 2024, which gives background regarding the phasing of the project.
- 2. One Copy of the utility sheets (Pg 1, 14-21, 24, 50-51) of the plan set entitled "Preliminary and Final Major Site Plan & Technical Subdivision, Wall 34 Realty L.L.C., Proposed Multi-Family Residential Development, Block 930, Lots 6 & 18, Township of Wall, Monmouth County, New Jersey", prepared by Anthony J. Calvano, P.E. of Colliers Engineering & Design, dated September 15, 2021, and last revised October 4, 2024.
- 3. One copy of a sewer report entitled "Engineer's Report for Sanitary Sewer, Wall 34 Realty, LLC, Block 930, Lots 6 & 18, Township of Wall, Monmouth County, New Jersey", prepared by Anthony J. Calvano, P.E. of Colliers Engineering & Design, dated October 31, 2022, and revised December 6, 2023.
- 4. One copy of a technical specification entitled "Technical Specifications for Sanitary Sewer, Wall 34 Realty, LLC, Block 930, Lots 6 & 18, Township of Wall, Monmouth County, New Jersey", prepared by Anthony J. Calvano, P.E. of Colliers Engineering & Design, dated October 31, 2022, and revised September 17, 2024.
- 5. One copy of the following updated completed forms:
  - a. TWA-1 Form
  - b. WQM-006 Form
  - c. WQM-003 Form

- 6. One scan of the check issued to the TNSA for \$750.
- 7. One copy of NJDEP TWA Permit No. 24-0258, dated October 10, 2024, for the approval of Phase 1.
- 8. One copy of the fully executed Settlement Agreement By and Between Township of Wall, Wall 34 Realty, LLC, Township of Neptune, Township of Neptune Sewerage Authority, and Ocean Grove Sewerage Authority, dated August 14, 2024.

The applicant is proposing to build a sanitary sewer system to service a new multi-family residential development and connect it to the Wall Township Sanitary Sewer system. The site is currently vacant woodlands, with a portion of the site containing remnants of excavation pits from prior mining operations on an adjacent lot.

The proposed sanitary sewer system will consist of 3,971 LF of 8" PVC SDR-35 sanitary sewer main that conveys flow from 296 townhouse units. Each townhouse will be serviced by a 4" PVC SDR-35 lateral. The proposed sanitary sewer system will be gravity fed to the proposed onsite pump station, which will be pumped via 1,666 LF of 6" HDPE force main to an existing manhole on Route 34.

For the resubmitted TWA application, this project has been divided into two phases:

Phase 1 consists of the sanitary flow for proposed Buildings 1-6 & 11-26, the proposed clubhouse, & the proposed pool. Construction is to be completed of all sanitary sewer manholes, gravity main, force main, and pump station.

Phase 2 will consist of the sanitary flow for proposed Buildings 7-10 & 27-29 as well as approval for construction and operation of Manhole S-168 & the immediate downstream sanitary sewer pipe (189 LF of 8" PVC).

Based upon the reviewed provided projected calculated flows, the facility will generate a total of 21,600 GPD of sanitary sewage with **TWA Phase 2**. This will be above the threshold of 8,000 GPD required for a Treatment Works Approval from the NJDEP. A **Treatment Works Approval will be required.** 

With the approval of TWA Phase 2 of this project, upon completion, the approximate utilization and capacity will be adjusted according to the following:

Customer Reserved Capacity*:	606,000	gallons per day
Customer Recorded Utilization:	95,920	gallons per day
Customer Reserved Utilization:	172,247	gallons per day
Customer Total Utilization:	268,167	gallons per day
Total Remaining Capacity:	337,833	gallons per day
