

Wastewater Treatment Plant Tour

Take a tour of our Wastewater Treatment Plant and visit with our staff for a question-and-answer session.

Member Municipalities: Avon-by-the-Sea, Borough of Bradley beach, Borough of Neptune City, Township of Neptune, Ocean Grove, Borough of Tinton Falls and Wall Township.

The Township of Neptune Sewerage Authority owns and operates an 8.5 million gallon per day (MGD) wastewater treatment plant that serves seven (7) municipalities in Monmouth County. Every day, TNSA treats approximately 5.5 million gallons of wastewater to protect the public's health and environment. Our treatment plant offers tours to show the general public how the water the municipalities use is cleaned and safely returned to the environment.

Tour Information:

- Tours are free;
- Tours are given during regular business hours, Monday through Friday, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m.
- Reservations must be made at least two (2) weeks in advance.
- Tours are about two (2) hours long, beginning with an orientation and ending with a question-and-answer period.
- The minimum age for tour participants is (5th) grade.
- The maximum group size is (30) people. There should be a chaperone for every (10) students/minors.
- Tour guides are the employees who operate and manage the wastewater treatment plant.
- To request a tour, please follow the instructions below.
- Tours are primarily outdoors; therefore, tours are weather permitting for the safety of all visitors.
